



Important Notes:

- 1) Pattern must be to scale and be able to tile **vertically** and **seamlessly** and must be 500 mm wide. It can be any height. If your pattern can tile horizontally, it can be saved at any width.
- 2) File must be saved as a high-quality print PDF without any crop or registration marks. Do not include a bleed.
- 3) Zoom in to 100% and take note of the scale of your pattern. This is the size it will be printed at.

Other Media Widths:

The same instructions apply for our other papers such as satin wrapping paper, bond paper, newsprint paper, etc. Please take note of the different widths though, and adjust your artboard width accordingly:

- Satin wrapping paper (500 mm)
- Bond paper (610 mm)
- Brown kraft paper (480 mm)
- Newsprint paper (860 mm)

How to Make a Tileable Pattern

- 1) Create and save pattern using Object > Pattern > Make
- 2) Create a rectangle that fits into the artboard (500 mm wide) and select the pattern swatch as the fill.
- 3) Select the rectangle and expand the shape using Object > Expand... Click OK.
- 4) Select your shape and release the clipping mask (Object > Clipping Mask > Release)
- 5) Ungroup the resulting object and select a row or two of the rectangles (these are tileable). Tile them so that they fill the artboard. Adjust the height of the artboard to fit the artwork, if necessary.
